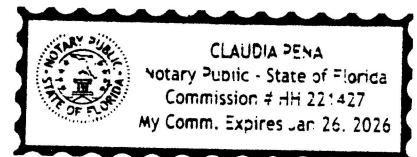

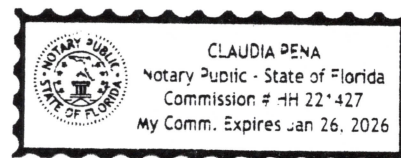

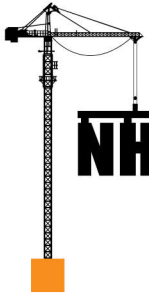

4. Question: Will the contractor be responsible for dewatering the pool, or will the city handle it?

Answer: The pool has already been dewatered. It has been determined that the groundwater level is not high enough to require any additional dewatering measures by the Contractor.

5. Question: Is there a special form for the warranty bond or performance & payment bonds?

Answer: There is a Public Construction Bond form included within this project's invitation to bid package (just after the sample agreement) which can be used. The City is also willing to accept forms provided by the contractor's bonding company. A warranty bond will not be required on this project.

6. Question: How long will the warranty bond be in effect?

Answer: A warranty bond will not be required on this project. Disregard references to a warranty bond.

7. Question: Is the Public Construction Bond to take the place of the performance & payment bonds or is it an entirely separate bond? Can you confirm that we will need to furnish four (4) bonds for this project?

Answer: If your bid is over \$200,000, you must submit a letter from your bonding company stating that you can obtain a Public Construction Bond if awarded the project. See State Statute 255.05 for more detailed information on Public Construction Bonds. A warranty bond will not be required on this project. The terms Public Construction Bond and Performance and Payment Bonds are used interchangeably in this solicitation to refer to the requirement to provide a Surety Bond that protects the Owner from performance and payment issues related to the project.

8. Question: Will the contractor be responsible for wrapping the PVC membrane over the gutter system to match existing?

Answer: Yes.

# CITY OF \_\_\_\_\_ FINANCIAL SERVICES GAINESVILLE PROCEDURES MANUAL

## **41-423      Prohibition of lobbying in procurement matters**

Except as expressly set forth in Resolution 060732, Section 10, during the blackout period as defined herein no person may lobby, on behalf of a competing party in a particular procurement process, City Officials or employees except the purchasing division, the purchasing designated staff contact. Violation of this provision shall result in disqualification of the party on whose behalf the lobbying occurred.

Black out period means the period between the issue date which allows for immediate submittals to the City of Gainesville Purchasing Department for an invitation for bid or the request for proposal, or qualifications, or information, or the invitation to negotiate, as applicable, and the time the City Officials and Employee awards the contract.

Lobbying means when any natural person for compensation, seeks to influence the governmental decision making, to encourage the passage, defeat, or modification of any proposal, recommendation or decision by City Officials and Employees, except as authorized by procurement documents.
