RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01

A RESOULUTION ENCOURAGING
THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE COMMISSION
TO RECONSIDER RESIDENTS CONCERNS
OVER THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE
AT UNIVERSITY AVENUE AND NW 2ND STREET

WHEREAS, in an effort to assist local businesses and restaurants through the national pandemic crisis which started in 2020, the City of Gainesville allowed certain streets to temporarily be closed so that adjoining restaurants could provide outdoor dining; and

WHEREAS, several residents from the Pleasant Street Historic District appeared in front of the City Commission, including meetings held on July 19, 2021 and November 18, 2021 to request that the temporary street closure at NW 2nd Street and University Avenue be reopened; and

WHEREAS, residents appeared before the Historic Preservation Board on March 1, 2022 to express concerns that one of their major entrances into their historic district has been restricted, potentially affecting response times from rescue vehicles, and also makes access for their own residents more difficult since nearby streets are one-way, limiting the ways to enter the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, those residents also expressed concerns that the outdoor dining space is currently unattractive, is not being kept up, and is not being utilized enough to warrant the street remaining closed; and

WHEREAS, some residents feel that this particular closure impacts a local neighborhood much more than the downtown block that is currently closed off at SW 1st Avenue, which the City has considered keeping permanently pedestrian.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA that the City Commission consider rehearing the street closure issue at an upcoming commission meeting to try and resolve the concerns of Pleasant Street's residents, and to let the Pleasant Street Neighborhood association or interested parties know at what meeting this may be scheduled for.
