In 2017, Tom Petty Birthday Bash was created in Gainesville, FL as a way to heal over the death of the local legend. 2018

2020

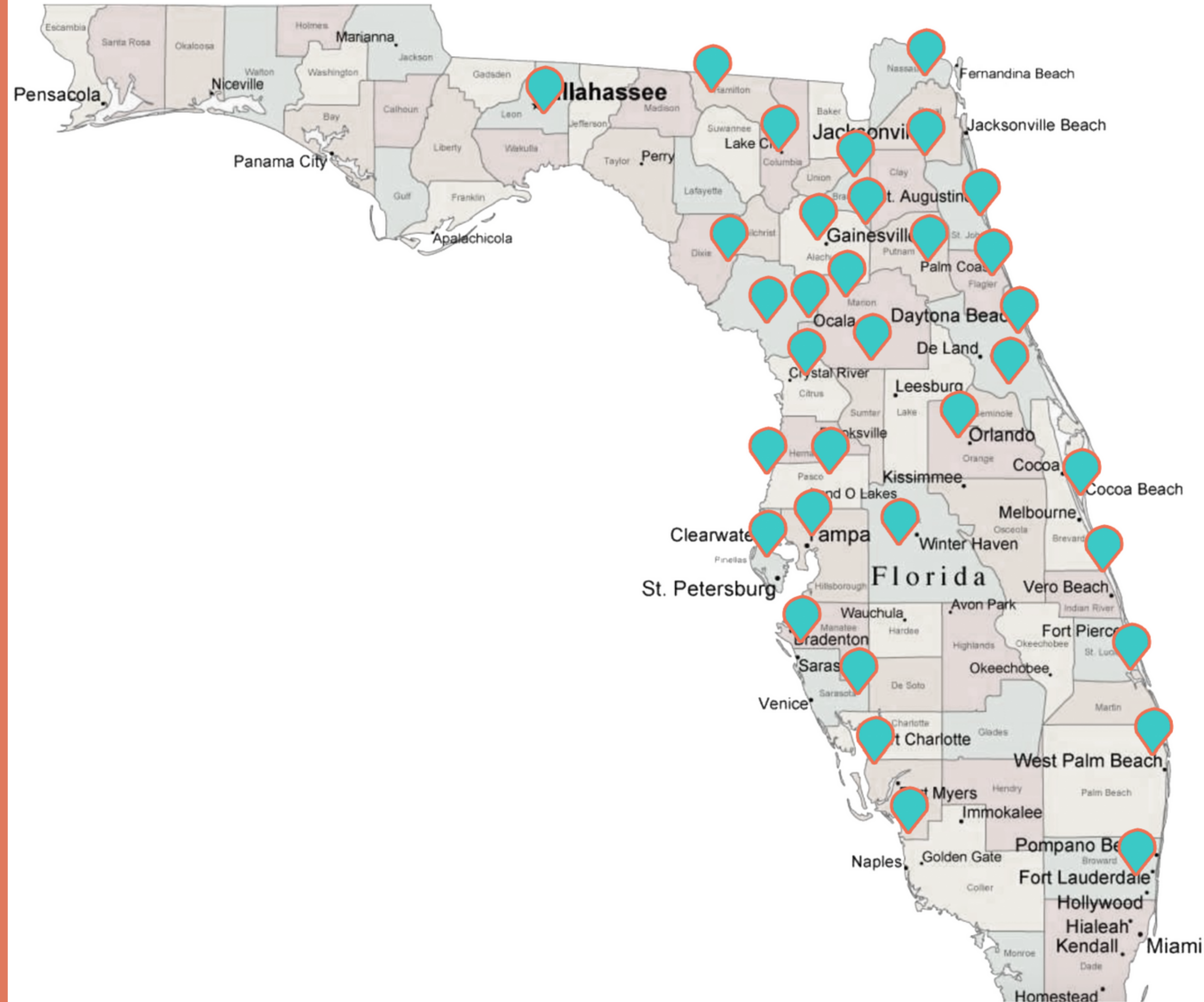

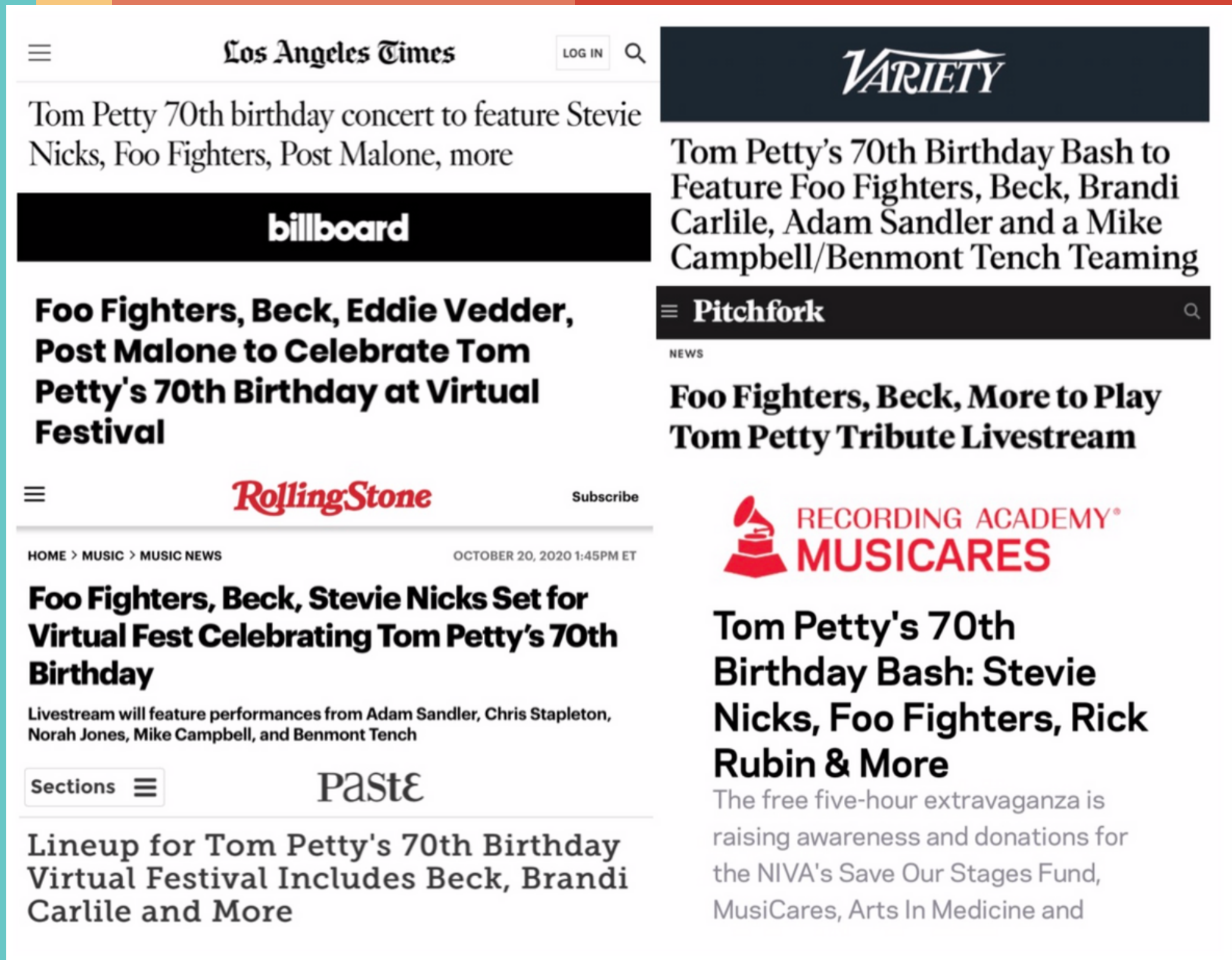
