WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting our city; and

WHEREAS, fire is a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and homes are the locations where people are at greatest risk for fire; and

WHEREAS, home fires killed more than 2,600 people in the United States in 2010, according to the latest research from the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA); and

WHEREAS, residents who have planned and practiced a home fire escape plan are more prepared and will therefore be more likely to survive a fire; and

WHEREAS, Gainesville's first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Have Two Ways Out!" effectively serves to remind us to develop and practice a home fire escape plan during Fire Prevention Week and year-round.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Craig Lowe, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim October 7-13, 2012 as

Fire Prevention Week

in the City of Gainesville and invite all our citizens to join me in practicing their home fire escape plans during Fire Trevention Week 2012, and to support the many public safety activities and efforts of Gainesville's fire and emergency services.
