An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Chapter 30, Appendix A, Section 8, Exhibit A(f)(9) of the Land Development Code, relating to the prohibited uses within the Five Points Special Area Plan; by adding social services (MG-83), residences for destitute people, food distribution centers for the needy, membership organizations (MG-86), dormitories, rooming houses and boarding houses (GN-702), rehabilitation centers, and social services homes or halfway houses to the list of prohibited uses; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

**WHERE** 

WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the text of the Land

Development Code of the City of Gainesville, Florida, be amended; and

WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public hearing was then held by the City Plan Board on July 17, 2008; and

WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law of a public hearing which was then held by the City Commission on September 2, 2008; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of the Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7) days after the first advertisement was published; and

WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second Public Hearing to be held at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was published; and
