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4	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending

8 9	83), residences for destitute people, food distribution centers for the needy, membership organizations (MG-86),
10	dormitories, rooming houses and boarding houses (GN-702),
11	rehabilitation centers, and social services homes or halfway
12	houses to the list of prohibited uses; providing directions to the
13	codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing
14	clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
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17	WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the text of the Land
18	Development Code of the City of Gainesville, Florida, be amended; and
19	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
20	hearing was then held by the City Plan Board on July 17, 2008; and
21	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law of a public hearing
22	which was then held by the City Commission on September 2, 2008; and
23	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches
24	long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of the Public Hearing to
25	be held in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at
26	least seven (7) days after the first advertisement was published; and
27	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was
28	placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second Public Hearing to be held at
29	least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was published; and

1	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described above at
2	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
3	heard.
4	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
5	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
6	Section 1. Chapter 30, Appendix A, Section 8, Exhibit A(f)(9) of the Land Development
7	Code of the City of Gainesville, is amended to read as follows:

33	<b>Section 2.</b> It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this
34	ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville,

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1	Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in
2	order to accomplish such intentions.
3	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or
4	the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding
5	shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect
6	without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of
7	this ordinance are declared severable.
8	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
9	such conflict hereby repealed.
10	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
