- Identify funding source




## **Overview**

- Continuous sidewalks are provided along all major corridors
- Multimodal system plan is developed to enhance the bike/ped network
- Funding source is identified and funds are programmed yearly for system expansion




# **Expanded Downtown Area**






# **Expanded Downtown Area**
