New Process & Findings

- Gainesville must notify the state land planning agency by May 1, 2012 if our comprehensive plan needs to be amended to comply with HB 7207 requirements
- Staff has determined that amendments to Comp Plan are necessary

Notification Letter

- Exhibit A-1 is the notification letter
- Failure to timely submit the City's letter by May 1, 2012 will mean that the City can no longer amend its comp plan until we comply
- Seeking authorization to transmit the letter to the State Land Planning Agency at the Dept. of Economic Opportunity



Amendments

- Amendments are necessary and must be transmitted to the State Land Planning Agency by May 1, 2013
- The amendments will be reviewed under the "State Coordinated Review Process" & will focus only on changes due to State requirements
- Failure to submit the amendments on time will mean the City can no longer amend its comprehensive plan



Summary of proposed amendments

Amendments needed for these elements:

- Future Land Use
- Transportation Mobility
- Concurrency Management
- Housing
- Capital Improvements
- Public Schools Facilities
- Conservation



Summary of proposed amendments

- Majority of amendments will be to the Future Land Use; Transportation Mobility; & Concurrency Management Elements
- Overall general changes
 - Remove Rule 9J-5 references
 - Update Data & Analysis and amend maps to show current city limits



Future Land Use Element

- Changes to the Future Land Use Map
 - Add historic districts/historically significant properties
 - Show existing & proposed potable water wells
- Policy about school location near urban residential areas
- Policy referencing sprawl indicators



Future Land Use Element cont.

 Amend policies containing language about the City's TCEA if it is eliminated in the Concurrency Management Element

• Add policy that references the State requirement that a proposed plan amendment must promote a development pattern or form that achieves 4 or more of the following:



Future Land Use cont.

- Protection of natural resources & ecosystems
- Promotes efficient provision of public infrastructure & services
- Promotes walkable/connected communities
- Promotes water & energy conservation
- Preserves agricultural areas
- Preserves open space
- Creates a balance of land uses based on residential population and demand for nonresidential needs of an area
- Remediates an existing sprawl pattern



Transportation Mobility & Concurrency Management

- Possibly merge the 2 elements
- Decisions about TCEA and changing TCEA zones to Transportation Mobility Zones or eliminate transportation concurrency
- Updates to the Gainesville Trail
 Network map to include recreation traffic routes
- Inclusion of levels of service for pedestrian, bicycle & transit modes?



Other Elements

Housing:

- Policy about creation or preservation of affordable housing
- Public Schools Facilities:
 - Policy about allowing proportionate fair share contributions
 - Amend LOS requirements as updated by the interlocal agreement
 - Delete references to "financially feasible" since this was eliminated from State law



Other Elements cont.

- Conservation, Open Space & Groundwater Recharge:
 - Policy about air quality

- Capital Improvements:
 - Amend public schools facilities LOS as needed due to changes in the inter-local agreement



Plan Board Schedule

- Must transmit all element amendments prior to May 1, 2013 deadline
- Plan Board Public hearing Schedule:
 - May 24: Overall discussion of major changes related to element policies
 - June 21: Conservation
 - July 26: Future Land Use
 - August 23: Transportation Mobility & Concurrency Management
 - September 27: Public Schools Facilities



Plan Board Schedule continued

- October 25: Capital Improvements & finalization of any hanging elements
- December 3: Housing
- All Plan Board public hearings must be completed by December to meet deadlines
- Items may overflow to the next meeting
- Staff may have to arrange special meetings



City Commission Schedule

- All elements needing update will be brought to the City Commission for public hearing
- All amendments transmitted must be adopted on first reading at a single CC meeting (April 4, 2013)
- Anticipate the first public hearings with the City Commission will begin in September or October 2012



Staff Recommendation

Authorize staff to transmit the Evaluation and Appraisal Notification letter to the State Land Planning Agency (Dept. of Economic Opportunity) prior to May 1, 2012
