Reason for Change

- Review of the Flood Control District indicated that the Code favored the use of the older Master Flood Control Planning Maps over the more current FEMA FIRM maps
- Code did not provide for use of "best available data" in the form of updated studies provided by an applicant
- Staff noted differences in flood channel lines using different maps



Text Changes to Flood Control District Section of the LDC

- **Primary Changes:**
- 1. Add new definitions
- 2. Amend several definitions
- 3. Delete some outdated definitions
- 4. Text changes concerning flood maps (best available data)
- 5. Remove references to the master flood control planning maps because of the age of the data

Deletion of several outdated or unused definitions
