ORIGINAL ORDINANCE

PURPOSE

- To reduce or eliminate unlawful consumption of alcoholic beverages by underage persons in alcoholic beverage establishments.*
- To protect the safety and health of our youth and community.*

RECOMMENDED ACTION

 Implement an ordinance that will restrict patronage after
 9:00pm of persons under 21 years of age in alcoholic beverage establishments that repeatedly suffer or permit underage persons to unlawfully possess or consume alcoholic beverages.*

RESULTS OF ORDINANCE

BEFORE ESTABLISHMENT 20062008

- \$222,000 spent on overtime pay it cost to patrol downtown on weekend nights.*
- \$125,000 spent in 2008 alone.*

AFTER ESTABLISHMENT 2009

- Overtime costs have all but disappeared.*
- Underage drinking arrests have dropped dramatically.
 - 2007: 995 Arrests*
 - 2008: 914 Arrests*
 - 2009: 441 Arrests*

CASE STUDY: 101 CANTINA

PROBATIONARY PERIOD 2010-2011 VS. SAME PERIOD IN 2012

- Sales down 38% during probationary period
- -\$250,000 in Revenue during probationary period
- 4.25 patrons turned away due to intoxication during probationary period.
- 40.29 (+963%) patrons turned away due to intoxication during the same period in 2012.

IN TRAINING

- Annual participation in GPD training courses
- All managers have received certification in crowd management
- Security team meetings held regularly
- Security personnel reviews held regularly

ECONOMIC IMPACT

- Attracts 7,000+ visitors, many of which are from out of town
- \$1.8 million revenue generated for the College Park area annually
- Generates \$108,000 in tax revenue annually
- Creates/Saves hundreds of jobs during the slow summer season

PROPOSAL

- Word ordinance to read the same as original ordinance.
- Allow special event permits to be issued.
- •Issue permits contingent up 21+ after 9pm.
- Original ordinance applies to special event premise extensions.
- Create a SOP of security mandates and regulations.
- •Create a security program similar GFR crowd management program.
