Purpose of Program

- Protect the wastewater system from harmful discharges
- Ensure GRU wastewater facilities comply with permits
- Protect the environment



Regulatory Overview

- FDEP oversees all Municipal Pretreatment Programs in Florida (about 60).
- EPA oversees state programs (FDEP equivalent in all states).
- State Rules are in Florida Administrative Code 62-625
- EPA Rules are in Chapter 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations.



City Ordinance

- Pretreatment Section (27-180) is required & reviewed/approved by FDEP
- **City Ordinance must be modified because:**
 - EPA revised federal regulations---40 CFR 403
 - FDEP revised state regulations---FAC 62-625
 - Therefore City Ordinance must reflect modifications
- All modifications to ordinance are in accordance with EPA model ordinance or directly required by FDEP

- Sec. 27-180.1. Same. Prohibited Substances
- □ Sec. 27-180.3. Same. Permitting.
- Sec. 27-180.4. Same. Monitoring, reporting and notification
- Sec. 27-180.5. Same. Pretreatment facilities and monitoring equipment
- Sec. 27-180.6. Same. Accidental discharge/slug prevention
- □ Sec. 27-180.7. Same Enforcement
- Sec. 27-180.8. Regulation of wastewater received from other jurisdictions



Recommendation

The City Commission authorize the City Attorney to prepare and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance amending the Gainesville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 27: Section 27-96 and 27-180, as may be necessary to meet the requirements of EPA and FDEP.
