2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, AMENDING APPENDIX A, SECTION UTILITIES, SUBSECTION (5), NATURAL GAS OF THE GAINESVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATES; DELETING INTERRUPTIBLE SERVICE RATES; AMENDING LARGE VOLUME INTERRUPTIBLE SERVICE RATES; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING DIRECTIONS TO THE CODIFIER; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND, PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE PROVIDED HEREIN.
15 16	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearings once by
17	publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of
18	the public hearings in the City Commission meeting room, first floor, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and
19	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described
20	above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in
21	fact, heard.
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
23	GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
24	Section 1. Appendix A, Section Utilities, Subsection (5), Natural Gas of the Gainesville
25	Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as set forth below. The remaining section, except
26	as provided below, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.
27	APPENDIX A – SCHEDULE OF FEES, RATES AND CHARGES
28	(5) Natural gas:
29	a. Appliance service and repair charges (§27-279):
30	1. Trip charge\$25.00
31	2. Labor charge, per one-half hour \$18.50

12	2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer cha	rge.
13	3. Purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-273)	
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15	c. General service rates (§27-272):	
16	1. Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for natural gas sales	
17	on a firm basis furnished by the City to consumers for general service	
18	are hereby fixed as follows:	
19	(i) Customer charge, per month, per bill rendered	\$35.00
20	(ii) Energy Charge, per therm	\$0.3430
21	(iii) Manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, per therm	\$0.0505
22	2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer cha	rge.
23	3. Purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-273)	
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25	d. Interruptible service rates (§27-272):	
26	1. Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for natural gas sales	
27	on an interruptible basis furnished by the City to consumers for	
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1	interruptible service are hereby fixed as follows:
2	(i) Customer charge, per month, per bill rendered\$375.00
3	(ii) Energy charge, per therm\$0.3150
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6	2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer charge plus a
7	minimum billing volume of natural gas as specified in the interruptible service contract.
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9	3. Purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-273)
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11	4. Make-up gas. If, in any month, the consumer does not take the minimum monthly quantity and as a
12	consequence is required to pay the sum of the non-fuel energy charge and the manufactured gas plant cost
13	recovery factor for natural gas not taken, then and in that event, the consumer shall be entitled to receive from
14	the City without payment of a further non-fuel energy charge and manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, at
15	any time within the subsequent eleven (11) months, a quantity of make-up gas equal to the quantity paid for but
16	not taken; provided, however, that consumer shall be entitled to receive make-up gas in a subsequent month
17	enly if and to the extent that the consumer has actually taken natural gas (excluding any natural gas taken in
18	violation of an interruption or curtailment order) in excess of the minimum monthly quantity during such
19	subsequent month. The minimum monthly quantity shall in each subsequent month be the first natural gas
20	taken. Consumer shall pay the Purchased Gas Adjustment charge applicable to such make up gas at the time it
21	is taken.
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23	5. Availability. This service is available to consumers in the natural gas service area both within and
24	outside the corporate limits of the City who have executed an Interruptible Gas Service Contract with the City
25	and only to the extent that supplies are available for this service under the City's service contracts with its
26	suppliers.
27	ed. Contract interruptible service rates (§27-272):

2 1. Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for natural gas sales on an interruptible basis 3 furnished by the City to consumers for contract interruptible service are hereby fixed as follows:

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6 Energy charge, per therm. A contract rate which is not less than the adjusted current cost of 7 alternative fuel and which is not greater than the sum of the non-fuel energy charge and the manufactured gas 8 plant cost recovery factor for interruptible service. In no event shall the contract rate be less than \$0.00 per 9

therm. The non-fuel energy charge for a consumer not complying with the provisions of section 5(ii) below shall be equal to the sum of the current non-fuel energy charge and the manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor

for interruptible service.

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2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer charge plus a minimum billing volume of natural gas as specified in the contract interruptible service contract.

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3. Purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-273)

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4. Make-up gas. If, in any month, the consumer does not take the minimum monthly quantity and as a consequence is required to pay the sum of the non-fuel energy charge and the manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor for natural gas not taken, then and in that event, the consumer shall be entitled to receive from the City without payment of a further non-fuel energy charge and manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, at any time within the subsequent eleven (11) months, a quantity of make-up gas equal to the quantity paid for but not taken; provided, however, that consumer shall be entitled to receive make-up gas in a subsequent month only if and to the extent that the consumer has actually taken natural gas (excluding any natural gas taken in violation of an interruption or curtailment order) in excess of the minimum monthly quantity during such subsequent month. The minimum monthly quantity shall in each subsequent month be the first natural gas

1	taken. Consumer shall pay the Purchased Gas Adjustment charge applicable to such make-up gas at the time it	
2	is taken.	
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4	5. Availability. This service is available to consumers in the natural gas service area both within and	
5	outside the corporate limits of the City:	
6	(i) who have executed an Contract Interruptible Gas Service Contract with the City; and,	
7	(ii) who have completed and submitted a Contract Interruptible Service Affidavit and	
8	Agreement form specifying their adjusted current cost of alternative fuel. Such forms shall	
9	be submitted monthly, on the first day of each month, and anytime there is a change to	
10	information contained in a form previously submitted; and,	
11	(iii) only to the extent that supplies are available for this service under the City's service	
12	contracts with its suppliers.	
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14	The city reserves the right, upon twenty-four (24) hours notice to the consumer and in the sole discretion of the	
15	general manager for utilities or his/her designee, to discontinue service under this rate classification or to	
16	discontinue the contract rate and to offer the consumer an increased contract rate, not to exceed the current	
17	non-fuel energy charge for interruptible service.	
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19	f. Large volume interruptible service rates (§27-272):	
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21	1. Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for natural gas sales on an interruptible basis	
22	furnished by the City to consumers for large volume interruptible service are hereby fixed as follows:	
23	(i) Customer charge, per month, per bill rendered	
24	(ii) Energy charge, per therm \$0.1573	
25	(iii) Manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, per therm	
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1	2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer charge plus the
2	minimum monthly quantity of 790,000 therms times the rate per therm, excluding the Purchased Gas
3	Adjustment, and shall apply to each billing or portion thereof.
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5	3. Purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-273)
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7	4. Make-up gas. If, in any month, the consumer does not take the minimum monthly quantity and as a
8	consequence is required to pay the sum of the non-fuel energy charge and the manufactured gas plant cost
9	recovery factor for natural gas not taken, then and in that event, the consumer shall be entitled to receive from
10	the City without payment of a further non-fuel energy charge and manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, at
11	any time within the subsequent eleven (11) months, a quantity of make-up gas equal to the quantity paid for but
12	not taken; provided, however, that consumer shall be entitled to receive make-up gas in a subsequent month
13	only if and to the extent that the consumer has actually taken natural gas (excluding any natural gas taken in
14	violation of an interruption or curtailment order) in excess of the minimum monthly quantity during such
15	subsequent month. The minimum monthly quantity shall in each subsequent month be the first natural gas
16	taken. Consumer shall pay the Purchased Gas Adjustment charge applicable to such make up gas at the time it
17	is taken.
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19	5. Availability. This service is available to consumers in the natural gas service area both within and
20	outside the corporate limits of the City who have executed a Large Volume Interruptible Gas Service Contract
21	with the City and only to the extent that supplies are available for this service under the City's service contracts
22	with its suppliers.
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24	e. Large Volume Interruptible service rates (§27-272)
25	1.Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for natural gas sales
26	on an interruptible basis furnished by the City to consumers for large volume interruptible service
27	are hereby fixed as follows:
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1	(i) Customer charge, per month, per bill rendered
2	(ii) Energy Charge, per therm\$0.20394
3	(iii) Manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor, per therm\$0.0505
4	2.Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer charge plus the
5	energy charge and manufactured gas plant cost recovery factor times 30,000 therms.
6	3.Purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-273)
7	4. Availability. This service is available to consumers in the natural gas service, both within and
8	outside the corporate limits of the City who meet the requirements as defined in §27-272.
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10	gf. Liquid propane gas service rates (§27-288.1):
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12	1. Base rate. The rates to be charged and collected for liquid propane gas sales furnished by the City
13	to consumers are hereby fixed as follows:
14	(i) Customer charge, per month, per bill rendered
15	(ii) Energy charge (Non-fuel), per gallon. A contract rate which shall equal the
16	sum of the current non-fuel energy charge for residential natural gas
17	customers and one of the following fixed charges as determined by the
18	general manager for utilities or his/her designee:
19	A. Three-year recovery, per gallon \$ 0.15
20	B. Five-year recovery, per gallon\$ 0.10
21	C. Seven-year recovery, per gallon\$ 0.075
22	D. More than seven-year recovery, per gallon\$ 0.03
23	2. Minimum Monthly Bill. The minimum monthly bill shall be equal to the customer charge.
24	3. Liquid propane purchased gas adjustment. (see Section 27-288.2)
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26	Ag. Curtailment penalty, per therm (§ 27-277(b)(3))
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1	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this
2	Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida,
3	and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to
4	accomplish such intentions.
5	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the
6	application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not
7	affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or
8	unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared
9	severable.
10	Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption; provided however,
11	the rates and charges as provided for herein shall be applicable to all monthly bills which are for the first
12	time rendered and postmarked after 12:01 A.M., October 1, 2012.
