## Strategic Initiative 6.1 - Develop Creative Ways to Measure Progress in Code Enforcement (B)

# Discuss the possibility of creating a Livability Court model in the City of Gainesville as it relates to Code Enforcement issues.

This item was introduced by Assistant City Manager Fred Murry, and the Committee heard a presentation from Interim Code Enforcement Manager Chris Cooper. The Committee also received input from Dan Nee with the City Attorney's Office, and Mr. Helmick, a citizen. After discussing the various issues and staff recommendations made in the presentation, Commissioner Hinson-Rawls made the following motion.

MOTION: The CDC recommends to the City Commission: 1) amend the Code of Ordinances to allow for the use of a Special Magistrate in lieu of the Code Enforcement Board; 2) include a funding increment of up to \$20,000 in the FY13/14 budget; 3) if funding is approved direct staff to draft an RFP for a Code Enforcement Special Magistrate; and 4) refer the issues of the Notice of Hearing Process, Civil Citation Process, and Landlord Permit Points Process back to the CDC for further discussion as part of item #090925 Strategic Initiative 6.1 - Develop Creative Ways to Measure Progress in Code Enforcement. Motion approved unanimously.

**RECOMMENDATION** The Community Development Committee: 1) approve staff's recommendations; 2) direct staff to provide the Community Development Committee's recommendation to the City Commission; and 3) remove this item from the Community Development Committee's referral list.
