## 1 **ORDINANCE NO. 120168** 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, 4 AMENDING APPENDIX A, SECTION UTILITIES, SUBSECTION (3), WATER, OF THE GAINESVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES 5 6 BY INCREASING INSPECTION SERVICE FEE; INCREASING 7 WATER MAIN TAPPING CHARGES; INCREASING METER 8 INSTALLATION CHARGES; INCREASING BASE RATES FOR 9 SERVICE; **INCREASING** WATER TRANSMISSION. 10 DISTRIBUTION AND WATER **TREATMENT** PLANT 11 CONNECTION CHARGES: INCREASING STANDBY FIRE LINE 12 CHARGES; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING 13 DIRECTIONS TO THE CODIFIER; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: AND, PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE 14 15 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE PROVIDED HEREIN. 16 WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearings once by 17 18 publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance 19 and of the public hearings in the City Commission meeting room, first floor, City Hall, City of 20 Gainesville; and 21 WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described 22 above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, 23 in fact, heard. 24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY 25 OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA: 26 Section 1. Appendix A, Section Utilities, Subsection (3), Water of the Gainesville Code 27 of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as set forth below.   - 1. For two (2) inches and smaller water meters. For applicants requiring water meters up to and including two-inch meter size, the water transmission and distribution connection charge shall be based on the size(s) of the water meter(s) installed according to the following:

- 2. For water meters serving multi-family units and water meters larger than two (2) inches, the water transmission and distribution connection charge shall be based on the estimated demand for service in accordance with the following:
  - (i) \$1.3931.433 per gallon per day (GPD) of annual average daily flow (ADF).
  - (ii) There will be a minimum charge of \$5,310.005,460.00 for meters larger than 2 inches.
- j. Water treatment plant connection charges (§ 27-129):
  - 1. For two (2) inches and smaller water meters. For applicants requiring water meters up to and including two-inch meter size, the water treatment plant connection charge shall be based on the size(s) of the water meter(s) installed according to the following:

16	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of
17	Section 1 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of
18	the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may
19	be renumbered or re-lettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
20	Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the
21	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
22	Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this
23	ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or
24	unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the
25	ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or
26	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
27	

1	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
2	provided however, the rates and charges as provided for herein shall be applicable to a
3	monthly bills which are for the first time rendered and postmarked after 12:01 A.M., October
4	1, 2012.
