RESOLUTION 120718

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF MOBIQUITY, INC. AS A QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY BUSINESS; AGREEING TO BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE UP TO TWO HUNDRED AND EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$208,000) AS LOCAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT IN THE QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY TAX REFUND PROGRAM; PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the business under consideration, Mobiquity, Inc., is a professional services company providing mobility services to the enterprise market; and

WHEREAS, Mobiquity, Inc., has corporate offices located in Wellesley, MA and proposes a development center at a new site within the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Mobiquity, Inc., in its new site, will employ 260 employees and is anticipated to begin hiring in FY 2013/14 with an average annual compensation of \$49,000 per year; and

WHEREAS, Mobiquity, Inc., will make a capital investment of \$820,000 over the next two years; and

WHEREAS, Mobiquity, Inc., intends to locate its new site in an Enterprise Zone designated pursuant to s.290.0065, Florida Statutes, within the City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida at a location yet to be determined.

WHEREAS, Mobiquity, Inc., intends to apply for the Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund for an Enterprise Zone location, pursuant to s.288.106(3), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the request by Mobiquity, Inc., has been reviewed by Enterprise Florida's primary economic development partner in Gainesville/Alachua County, the Gainesville/Alachua County Council for Economic Outreach and Gainesville Area Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2013, the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners approved funding 50% of the local financial support (\$208,000) towards this project; and,

WHEREAS, the Gainesville City Commission finds that the expenditure of City funds as local financial support for Mobiquity, Inc., constitutes a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FL:

- 1. That the Commission finds, determines, and declares that the recitals in the preamble are true and correct, and hereby incorporates them by reference.
- 2. That in accordance with Section 288.106(4)(2)(10), Florida Statutes, the City Commission recommends that Mobiquity, Inc., be approved as a Qualified Target Industry (QTI) Business.
- 3. That the City agrees to budget and appropriate up to \$208,000 as local financial support over a four year period commencing in FY 13 and running through FY 16 to the Florida Economic Development Trust Fund in the event that Mobiquity, Inc. is certified as a QTI Business and locates its business within the City of Gainesville corporate limits and specifically within the City's established Enterprise Zone.
- 4. The City of Gainesville has determined the basis of this project's average private sector wage calculation shall be Alachua County's average private sector annual wage of \$34,446 as determined by Enterprise Florida.
- 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
