14	in the City of Gainesville; and
15	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described
16	at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in
17	fact, heard; and
18	WHEREAS, the General Manager has evaluated Gainesville Regional Utilities'
19	organizational strengths and weaknesses and identified certain job titles where, should
20	incumbents fail to effectively and efficiently carry out the duties of the position, the vision and
21	mission of the organization would not be achieved. These mission-critical positions will be
22	designated as Directors of Departments pursuant to Section 3.06 of the Charter of the City of
23	Gainesville; and
24	WHEREAS, the employees occupying job titles designated as Directors of
25	Departments shall report to, be supervised and evaluated by, and be subject to termination and
26	lesser discipline at the will of the General Manager, and may also be authorized and directed

to provide daily supervision of another Director of a Department, to assist in evaluating the

1	performance of another Director of a Department, and to recommend discipline or other				
2	personnel actions relative to another Director of a Department;

- 1 renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions. 2 **Section 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this 3 ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the 4 5 ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or 6 application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable. 7 **Section 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent 8 of such conflict hereby repealed. 9
- **Section 5.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption; 10 however, the designation as Director of a Department for each of the job titles added in 11 Section 2-196(b) shall not become effective as to any particular job title until that job 12 title/position becomes vacant and an appointment is made after the effective date of this ordinance. 13
