- Partner with Terwilliger Elementary School
- Hosted 8 sessions with 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students
- Average of 45 students per session



#### **Full STEAM Ahead Summer Camp**



- Hosted 225 elementary and middle school students
- Held at 5 sites throughout city in partnership with Parks & Recreation
- Volunteer camp staff through UF College of Engineering and GRU employees



## **Fun Science Family Night**

- Held at Williams Elementary with 450 attendees, including more than 300 students
- Partnered with CADE Museum, Life South, University of Florida, Santa Fe College, and LGAA among many others





## **ACE Mentorship Program**

- Established the local affiliate chapter (Alachua/Marion)
- Board represents cross section of ACE industry, including UF/SFC
- Eastside High is 2012-2013 pilot site
- Weekly sessions teach technical/professional skills





#### **Brighter Tomorrow Banquet**

- Almost 250 attendees for Dr. Mae Jemison
- 4 scholars awarded \$4,000 each to pursue engineering degrees at UF
- Almost \$30,000 in scholarships awarded since inception in 2010





#### **STEM Teacher Grants**

- \$4,000 investment in the Education Foundation
- Williams Elementary, Irby Elementary and Chiles Elementary awarded grants
- Projects range from mathematics and spatial construction, science exploration, and terrarium habitats
