## 1 **ORDINANCE NO: 120767** 2 An Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending 3 Chapter 4 of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances, relating to alcoholic beverages; by creating and adding a new 4 5 subsection (6) to Sec. 4-4.(b) to provide an exception for the temporary outdoor sale, dispensing and consumption of beer 6 7 and wine at the Santa Fe College Spring Arts Festival; establishing a permit process and setting forth conditions and 8 9 requirements for the permit; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing 10 clause; and providing an immediate effective date. 11 12 WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given of the public hearing once by 13 14 publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission meeting room, first floor, City Hall in the City of 15 Gainesville: and 16 17 WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, 18 19 heard. 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA: 21 Section 1. Section 4-4(6), titled "Unlawful consumption and possession; authorized 22 special events", of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, is amended to add a new 23 24 subsection (6) as set forth herein. Except as amended herein, the remainder of Sec. 4-4.(b) remains in full force and effect. 25

Sec. 4-4(b). - Unlawful consumption and possession; authorized special events.

- (6) Exception: Santa Fe College Spring Arts Festival.
- 28 <u>a. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to issue a special</u>
  29 permit for the temporary sale of beer (as defined in Section 563.01,

1		<u>Florida</u>	Statutes) and wine (as defined in Section 564.01, Florida
2		Statute	es) on a public street, sidewalk, right-of-way or thoroughfare,
3		incider	ntally associated with the Santa Fe College Spring Arts
4		Festiva	al subject to the provisions of this subsection.
5	<u>b.</u>	A pern	nit application must be submitted by Santa Fe College to the
6		City M	Sanager or designee, on the form provided by the City, along
7		with p	ayment of the fee as set forth in Appendix A of this Code at
8		least 3	0 days prior to the first date of the event.
9		<u>1.</u>	The special event permit application shall include a site
10			plan sketch showing the location, access, barriers
11			delineating the event site from other public areas and all
12	*		other pertinent details of the site.
13		<u>2.</u>	The special event permit application shall include a report
14			detailing the dates and times during which the event will be
15			conducted, the estimated number of people expected to
16			attend, the capacity of any proposed temporary structures,
17			whether there will be outdoor entertainment, the installation
18			of temporary sanitary facilities, a plan for the storage and
19			pickup of garbage during and after the Santa Fe College
20			Spring Arts Festival event, and a public safety plan
21			detailing how the applicant will maintain crowd control and
22			public safety, and comply with the City's noise ordinance.
23		<u>3.</u>	The special event permit application shall be reviewed by
24			the appropriate departments of the City with respect to

1			protection of the public health, safety and general welfare.
2			In addition to normal concerns of each such department,
3			particular attention will be given to traffic flow and control,
4			auto and pedestrian safety, and the impact that the use and
5			activity will have on surrounding uses, particularly where
6			the adjoining uses include residential.
7		<u>4.</u>	The permit may be approved or denied by the City
8			Manager or designee based on compliance with this
9			subsection. The City Manager or designee may impose
10			additional special conditions as deemed necessary to
11			protect the public health, safety and general welfare.
12		<u>5.</u>	Only one special event permit may be issued per calendar
13			year.
14	<u>c.</u>	Each	permit issued shall be subject to the following conditions,
15		requir	rements and limitations, as well as any other special
16		condi	tions stated in the permit.
17		<u>1.</u>	The Santa Fe College Springs Art Festival event must be
18			sponsored by Santa Fe College and co-sponsored by the
19			<u>City.</u>
20		<u>2.</u>	The event shall include activities suitable for a broad range
21			of ages.
22		<u>3.</u>	A sufficient number of off-duty law enforcement officers.
23			as determined by the City, shall be employed by Santa Fe

1		College to provide security and crowd control for the Santa
2		Fe College Springs Art Festival event.
3	<u>4.</u>	Santa Fe College and any person authorized by Santa Fe
4		College as responsible for the sale or dispensing of beer
5		and/or wine shall stop such sale or dispensing at any time
6		upon determination of the City Manager or designee that
7		continued sale and consumption of beer and/or wine creates
8		a clear and present danger of a riot or other general public
9		disorder, and/or substantial injury to persons or to property.
10	<u>5.</u>	Santa Fe College shall indemnify the City, its elected and
11		appointed officers, employees, and agents from any claim
12		for personal injury, including death, or property damage,
13		including destruction, associated with the Santa Fe College
14		Spring Arts Festival event. This indemnification shall be in
15		the form of an insurance policy acceptable to the City's
16		Risk Manager, that names the City as an additional insured
17		and is endorsed to provide a separate aggregate of a
18		minimum of \$1,000,000.00 for the event. In addition, Santa
19		Fe College shall procure a liquor liability policy with not
20		less than \$1,000,000.00 of coverage that also names the
21		City as an additional insured.
22	<u>6.</u>	The Santa Fe College Springs Arts Festival event shall be
23		held on NE 1st Street between University Avenue and NE
24		8 <sup>th</sup> Avenue.

1	-	<u>7.</u>	The Santa Fe College Spring Arts Festival event shall not
2			begin before 9:00 a.m. on each day and shall end no later
3			than 8:30 p.m. each night of the festival weekend.
4		<u>8.</u>	Santa Fe College or any person authorized by Santa Fe
5			College as responsible for the sale or dispensing of beer
6			and/or wine shall comply with all local, state and federal
7			laws related to the sale, dispensing and consumption of
8			beer and/or wine.
9		<u>9.</u>	Santa Fe College shall not allow alcoholic beverages,
10			including beer or wine, purchased outside of the Santa Fe
11			College Spring Arts Festival event to be brought into or
12			consumed inside the permitted event area. Nor shall Santa
13			Fe College allow beer or wine sold inside the permitted
14			event area to be taken out of, or consumed outside of the
15			permitted event area.
16	Section 2. It is the in	ntentio	n of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of
17	this ordinance shall become	and b	be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
18	Gainesville, Florida, and that	the se	ections and paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered
19	or relettered in order to accom	nplish	such intentions.
20	Section 3. If any wor	rd, phr	ase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
21	or the application hereof to a	any per	rson or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
22	finding shall not affect the of	ther pr	ovisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
23	effect without the invalid o	or unco	onstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
24	provisions of this ordinance a	ire dec	lared severable.

1	Section 4. All ordinances or par	rts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
2	such conflict hereby repealed.	
3	Section 5. This ordinance shall	become effective immediately upon final adoption.
