

Petition / Background

- Major auto. dealership 1935 2008, used cars since April 2012
- Developed site w/approx 30,456 sq ft (auto showroom, warehouse) - needs redevelopment



Petition / Background

- Served by urban services, no impact on adopted LOS (water/wastewater, solid waste, recreation, schools)
- TCEA Zone B
- RTS Routes 6, 8 & 29 along NW 13th ST
- No known contamination or other environmental issues



Highlights – LUC

- Proposed MUL compatible w/area, incl'g MUL east side NW 13th ST between NW 23rd and NW 16th AVEs
- MUL would incr. redevelopment potential by allowing more uses & establishing Land Use category more compatible w/those in corridor



Highlights – LUC

Consistent w/pertinent Comp Plan goals, objectives & policies, incl'g those that encourage:

- mixed-use development where appropriate
- redevelopment
- restriction of auto sales & service to N
 Main ST north of 16th AVE
