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3	WHEREAS, Section 509.233, Florida Statutes, permits local governments to establish a
14	local exemption to certain provisions of the Food and Drug Administration Food Code in order
15	to allow patrons' dogs within certain designated outdoor portions of public food service
16	establishments; and
17	WHEREAS, notice was given as required by law that the text of the Land Development
18	Code of the City of Gainesville, Florida, be amended and public hearings were then held by the
19	City Plan Board on May 24, 2012 and by the City Commission on August 2, 2012; and
20	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10
21	inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation and provided the public with at
22	least seven (7) days advance notice of the first public hearing to be held in the City Hall
23	Auditorium, First Floor, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and
24	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long
25	was placed in the aforesaid newspaper and provided the public with at least five (5) days advance
26	notice of the second public hearing; and
27	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notice described above at which
28	hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were in fact heard

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE 1 2 CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA: 3 Section 1. A new Section 30-122 is created and added to the Land Development 4 Code to read as follows: 5 Sec. 30-122 – Patrons' dogs within outdoor portions of eating places. 6 7 (1)Purpose; intent; preemption. The purpose of this section is to provide a 8 local exemption to certain provisions of the Food and Drug Administration 9 Food Code, as authorized by Section 509.233, Florida Statutes, in order to 10 allow patrons' dogs within certain designated outdoor portions of eating 11 places. Nothing in this section is intended to conflict with, be inconsistent 12 with, or preempt state or federal law. To the extent of any such conflict, 13 inconsistency or preemption, the state or federal law shall prevail. 14 15 *Permit.* In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the general (2)16 public, each eating place shall obtain a permit from the city planning and 17 development services department prior to allowing patrons' dogs within outdoor portions of the eating place. Applicants shall submit a completed 18 19 permit application on the form provided by the city along with the permit 20 fee set forth in Appendix A. The application shall be signed by the 21 property owner and by the tenant or operator of the eating place (if 22 different from the property owner) and shall include such information 23 deemed reasonably necessary to enforce the provisions of this section, but 24 shall include, at a minimum, the following information: 25 26 The name, location and mailing address of the eating place. a. 27 28 The name, mailing address, telephone number and email b. 29 address of the permit applicant. 30 31 A diagram and description of the outdoor area to be 32 designated as available to patrons' dogs, including 33 dimensions of the designated area; a depiction of the number and placement of tables, chairs and restaurant 34 35 equipment, if any; the entryways and exits to the designated 36 outdoor area: the boundaries of the designated area and of

other areas of outdoor dining not available for patrons'

dogs; any fences or other barriers; surrounding property lines and public rights-of-way, including sidewalks and

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1 2 3 4	common pathways; and such other information reasonably required by the city. The diagram or plan shall be accurate and to scale but need not be prepared by a licensed design professional.
5 6 7 8	d. A description of the days of the week and hours of operation that patrons' dogs will be permitted in the designated outdoor area.
9 10 11 12	e. The license number for the eating place issued by the Florida Division of Hotels and Restaurants.
13 14 15 16 17	A permit issued pursuant to this section shall not be transferred to a subsequent property owner, tenant or operator upon the sale, lease, or other transfer of the eating place, but shall expire automatically upon the sale, lease or other transfer of the eating place. The city shall provide the Florida Division of Hotels and Restaurants with a copy of all approved applications and permits issued.
19 20 21 22	(3) Permit conditions. Each eating place receiving a permit under this section shall be subject to and shall enforce the following requirements:
23 24 25 26 27	a. Dogs shall not be permitted to travel through indoor or non- designated outdoor portions of the eating place. Ingress and egress to the designated outdoor portions of the eating place must not require entrance into or passage through any indoor area.
28 29 30 31	b. Patrons shall keep their dogs on a leash at all times and under reasonable control.
32 33 34	c. Dogs shall not be allowed on chairs, tables or other furnishings.
35 36 37 38	d. The eating place shall instruct employees and patrons that dogs shall not be allowed to come into contact with serving dishes, utensils, tableware, linens, paper products or any other items involved in food service operations.
39 40 41 42	e. All table and chair surfaces shall be cleaned and sanitized with an approved product between seating of patrons Spilled food and drink shall be removed from the floor or

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4	<u>f.</u>	Accidents involving dog waste shall be cleaned
5		immediately and the area sanitized. A kit with the
6		appropriate materials for this purpose shall be kept near the
7		designated outdoor area.
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9	g.	Employees shall wash their hands promptly after touching,
10	8	petting or otherwise handling dogs. Employees shall be
11		prohibited from touching, petting or otherwise handling
12		dogs while serving food or beverages or handling tableware
13		or before entering other parts of the eating place.

15	h.	The eating place shall advise patrons in the designated
16	11.	outdoor area that they should wash their hands before
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18		eating.

19	<u>i.</u>	Waterless hand sanitizer shall be provided at all tables in
20		the designated outdoor area.
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22	<u>J.</u>	A sign or signs shall be posted on the premises notifying
23		the public that the designated outdoor area is available for
24		the use of patrons and patrons' dogs. In addition, a sign or
25		signs shall be posted on the premises informing patrons and
26		employees of the requirements set forth in this section.
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28	(4) Complaints; e	enforcement.
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30	<u>a.</u>	Complaints regarding lack of compliance with this section
31		may be made in writing to the city code enforcement
32		division, which shall accept, document, and respond to all
33		written complaints and shall report to the Florida Division
34		of Hotels and Restaurants all complaints and the response
35		to such complaints.
36	b.	The city shall revoke a permit if, after providing notice and
37		a reasonable period of time for correction as specified in
38		the notice, an eating place is found to be in violation of any
39		provision of this section. The revocation shall be issued in
40		the form of a final administrative order signed by the city
41		manager or designee.
