## Proposed Extension of Solid Waste Residential Curbside Collection Contract

City agrees to:

- 1. Extend the contract from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2021.
- 2. Pay a rate increase of 6% on October 1, 2014.
- 3. Pay a rate increase of 6% on October 1, 2018.
- 4. Extend allowable average service life of WCA curbside collection trucks from four to eight years.
- 5. Pay a Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) fuel adjustment of (two options):
  - A. Flat rate of \$0.10 per household (HH) per month or
  - B. Shared risk of future increases

## WCA agrees to:

- 1. Convert residential solid waste collection trucks operating within Alachua County to CNG five (5) months from contract-extension agreement date.
- 2. Eliminate diesel fuel surcharge and replace with a flat rate of \$0.10 per HH per month for CNG service (option A).
- 3. Calculate CNG fuel adjustment surcharge based on fuel consumed (option B).
- 4. Reduce 8% rate increase scheduled for October 2014 to 6%.
- 5. Cease accepting, processing or transferring MSW at its Bear Archery Road solid waste facility.
- 6. Establish deed restrictions on the Bear Archery Road solid waste facility site to prohibit the operation of a transfer station for MSW on the property for perpetuity.
- 7. Deliver all waste collected in Alachua County to the Leveda Brown Transfer Station as of two (2) weeks from contract extension date.
- 8. Provide a publicly accessible fast fill CNG fueling station by October 1, 2014.
- 9. Limit transfer station operations to C&D and Class III waste only.
