JUSTIFICATION & USEFUL LIFE:

The Thomas Center Facilities currently have problems with dry wood termites. The facilities department has been spot treating specific areas when swarms are present, but the building will need to be tented to completely eliminate the pest from the facilities. It is critical that this work be completed to maintain the long-term structural integrity of the facility.

However, it should be noted that we have been advised by our existing termite treatment provider that the treatment is a one-time treatment. The treatment carries no guarantees that the problem will not reoccur in the future. This is due to the nature of the pest itself and general area in which the facility is located. Dry wood termites live in wood and not in the ground like subterranean termites. They spread when they swarm and lay their eggs. A swarm from the outside could very easily infiltrate the facilities and cause the problem to reoccur. The area in which the Thomas Center is located is notorious for having problems with dry wood termites.
