WHEREAS, the United Nations Association of the USA has declared "Why the World Still Needs the UN and How the UN needs the World" as its theme for the 2013 United Nations Day commemoration; and

WHEREAS, the Gainesville Chapter is committed to educating and mobilizing our local communities to build a stronger network of citizens and leaders to create a more prosperous, just and sustainable world; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Elisabeth Renner has been appointed Chair of the UN Day Committee in Gainesville to work with local UNA-USA members and community leaders to organize events and activities in celebration of UN Day and to educate citizens about the UN's work.
