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1	ORDINANCE NO. 130243

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, annexing a certain portion of the City of Gainesville reserve area, as petitioned for by the property owner pursuant to Chapter 90-496, as amended, Special Act, Laws of Florida, known as the Alachua County Boundary Adjustment Act, that comprises Tax Parcel Nos. 07240-030-000, 07240-001-010, and 07242-001-000, along with a portion of the right-of-way of SW 41st Boulevard, and which is generally located south of SW Archer Road, west of Fred Bear Drive and I-75, north of SE Williston Road, and east of SW 62nd Avenue; making certain findings; providing for inclusion of the area in Appendix I of the City Charter; providing for land use plan, zoning, and subdivision regulations, and enforcement of same; providing for persons engaged in any occupation, business, trade, or profession; providing directions to the Clerk of the Commission; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, Chapter 90-496, Special Acts, Laws of Florida, as amended by Chapter 91-382 and Chapter 93-347, Special Acts, Laws of Florida, created the "Alachua County Boundary Adjustment Act" ("Act"), which sets forth procedures for the annexation of contiguous, compact, unincorporated territory within a municipality's reserve area; and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2011, the Board of County Commissioners of Alachua County designated an updated reserve area boundary for the City of Gainesville pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2013, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville received a petition for voluntary annexation of real property located in the unincorporated area of Alachua County and within the City of Gainesville's reserve area, as more specifically described in this ordinance, and determined that the petition included the signatures of all owners of property in the area proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2013, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 130098, which adopted the Urban Services Report setting forth the plans to provide urban services to that

1	portion of the reserve area proposed to be annexed in accordance with the procedures provided in		
2	the Act; and		
3	WHEREAS, a copy of the Urban Services Report was filed with the Alachua County Board		
4	of County Commissioners; and		
5	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville desires to annex a certain portion of its reserve area		
6	that is compact and contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City; and		
7	WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, notice has been published in a newspaper of general		
8	circulation at least once a week for two consecutive weeks prior to first reading notifying the public		
9	of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings in the City Commission Auditorium located on		
10	the first floor of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and		
11	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notice described above during		
12	which the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.		
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
14	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		
15	Section 1. The City Commission finds that the Area described in Section 2 of this		
16	ordinance ("Area") is reasonably compact and contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City		
17	of Gainesville and that no part of the Area is within the boundary of another municipality or outside		
18	of the county in which the City of Gainesville lies. The City Commission finds the Area to be		
19	within its reserve area and the annexation does not create an enclave.		
20	Section 2. The following described Area is annexed and incorporated within the corporate		
21	limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida:		
22 23 24	See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the Area is shown on Exhibit "B" for visual reference. In the		

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1 2 3	event of conflict or inconsistency, Exhibit "A" shall prevail over Exhibit "B."
4	Section 3. The corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida, as set forth in Appendix
5	I, Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville, are amended and revised to include the Area as described
6	in Section 2 of this ordinance within the corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida.
7	Section 4. In accordance with Section 171.062, Florida Statutes, the Alachua County land
8	use plan and zoning or subdivision regulations shall remain in full force and effect in the Area
9	described in Section 2 of this ordinance until the City of Gainesville adopts a comprehensive plan
10	amendment that includes the annexed area. Prior to the City's adoption of a comprehensive plan
11	amendment that includes the annexed area, the City may rezone properties in the annexed area to ar
12	Alachua County zoning category that conforms with the Alachua County Comprehensive Plan. The
13	City of Gainesville shall have jurisdiction to enforce these regulations during the interim period
14	through the City of Gainesville code enforcement process as described in Division 8 of Article V or
15	Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville and the Civil Citation Process, as
16	described in Division 6 of Article V of Chapter 2 of said Code.
17	Section 5. (a) All persons who are, as of the effective date of this ordinance, lawfully
18	engaged in any occupation, business, trade, or profession within the Area described in Section 2 or
19	this ordinance shall have the right to continue such occupation, business, trade, or profession, bu
20	shall obtain a business tax receipt from the City of Gainesville for the term commencing on October
21	1, 2014, which tax receipt shall be issued upon payment of the appropriate fee in accordance with
22	the Gainesville Code of Ordinances in effect on October 1, 2014.
23	(b) All persons who are, as of the effective date of this ordinance, lawfully engaged
24	in any construction trade, occupation, or business within the Area described in Section 2 of this

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1	ordinance and who possess a valid certificate of competency issued by Alachua County shall hav		
2	the right to continue the construction trade, occupation, or business within the entire corporate limit		
3	of the City of Gainesville, including the Area, subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations		
4	imposed on the certificate by Alachua County, and provided that such persons register the certificate		
5	with the Building Inspections Division of the City of Gainesville and the Department of Business		
6	and Professional Regulation of the State of Florida, if applicable, on or before 4:00 p.m. of the		
7	effective date of this ordinance.		
8	Section 6. The Clerk of the Commission is directed to submit a certified copy of this		
9	ordinance to: 1) the Florida Department of State; and 2) the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the Eight		
10	Judicial Circuit in and for Alachua County, Florida.		
11	Section 7. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance		
12	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such		
13	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be give		
14	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the		
15	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.		
16	Section 8. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the		
17	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.		
18	Section 9. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

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


LEGAL DESCRIPTION

THIS DESCRIPTION INCLUDES RIGHT-OF-WAY OF SW 41ST BOULEVARD

A TRACT OF LAND SITUATED IN THE GARY GRANT, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCE AT THE NORTH CORNER OF THAT TRACT OF LAND AS DESCRIBED IN OFFICIAL RECORDS BOOK 3242, PAGE 404 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ALACHUA COUNTY, FLORIDA (HEREAFTER ABBREVIATED AS ORB, __PAGE __ ACR), ALSO BEING A POINT ON THE NORTHEASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF SW 41ST BOULEVARD AND EXISTING CITY LIMIT LINE AS PER ORDINANCE #080193 AND THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE HEREIN DESCRIBED TRACT; THENCE RUN SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG SAID NORTHEASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE TO THE EASTERLY EXTENSION OF THE SOUTH LINE OF THAT TRACT OF LAND LISTED AS PARCEL 1 AS DESCRIBED IN ORB 3827, PAGE 1316 ET SEQ. ACR; THENCE RUN SOUTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID EASTERLY EXTENSION AND THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID TRACT AND THE SOUTH LINE OF THAT TRACT OF LAND LISTED AS PARCEL 4 AS DESCRIBED IN SAID ORB 3827, PAGE 1316 ACR TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID PARCEL 4: THENCE RUN NORTHWESTERLY ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID PARCEL 4 TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID PARCEL 4, ALSO BEING ON THE EXISTING CITY LIMIT LINE AS PER SAID ORDINANCE #080193: THENCE ALONG SAID CITY LIMIT LINE TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE HEREIN DESCRIBED TRACT.
