Background

 Referral to the Plan Board from the City Commission (Legislative Matter No. 120202) as approved April 18, 2013

 CDC approved eliminating term limits for Development Review Board, City Plan Board, Board of Adjustment, and Historic Preservation Board (January 14, 2013)



Background

- The basis for the referral cited the need to:
 - Retain qualified volunteers to serve on quasi-judicial boards
 - Ensure that boards can meet quorum requirements and fulfill basic duties



Board Membership

 Each Board currently limits service to a maximum of 6 consecutive years (two 3-year terms). Reappointment is possible after one year absence

 Eliminating term limits will not alter the current three-year term durations and the City Commission will still need to reappoint members



Board Rules

 Each quasi-judicial board adopts rules of procedure that also will require revision.

 Changes to the rules of procedure must be approved by the individual boards and adopted by the City Commission



Recommendation

 Approve Petition PB-13-52 TCH and adopt Ordinance 130106

 Plan Board voted 5-1 to approve Petition PB-13-52 TCH
