What is Accreditation?

 "A Continuous Improvement Model Through Self-Assessment" – CFAI



- Developed in the mid-1980s by the International Association of Fire Chiefs (IAFC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA)
- Managed by the Commission on Fire Accreditation International (CFAI) through the Center for Public Safety Excellence (CPSE)



The CFAI Mission

The mission of the Commission on Fire Accreditation International is to assist the fire and emergency service agencies throughout the world in achieving excellence through selfassessment and accreditation in order to provide continuous quality improvement and enhancement of service delivery to their communities.  GFR practices have been validated as aligning with the "best practice" models identified by National Standards such as the National Fire Protection Association




