1 **RESOLUTION NO. 130827** 2 3 PASSED April 3, 2014 4 5 A resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida 6 approving the Local Housing Assistance Plan as required by the State 7 Housing Initiatives Partnership Program Act, Sections 420.907-420.9079. Florida Statutes; and Chapter 67-37, Florida Administrative Code; 8 9 authorizing and directing the Mayor to execute any necessary documents and 10 certifications needed by the State; authorizing the submission of the Local 11 Housing Assistance Plan for review and approval by the Florida Housing 12 Finance Corporation; and providing an effective date. 13 14 WHEREAS, the State of Florida enacted the William E. Sadowski Affordable Housing 15 Act, Chapter 92-317 of Florida Sessions Laws, allocating a portion of documentary stamp taxes 16 on deeds to local governments for the development and maintenance of affordable housing; and 17 WHEREAS, the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Act, Sections 420.907-18 420.9079, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 67-37, Florida Administrative Code, requires local 19 governments to develop a one- to three-year Local Housing Assistance Plan outlining how funds 20 will be used; and 21 WHEREAS, the SHIP Act requires local governments to establish the maximum SHIP 22 funds allowable for each strategy; and 23 WHEREAS, the SHIP Act further requires local governments to establish an average 24 area purchase price for new and existing housing benefiting from awards made pursuant to the Act: The methodology and purchase prices used are defined in the attached Local Housing 25 26 Assistance Plan; and 27 WHEREAS, as required by Section 420.9075, Florida Statutes, it is found that 5 percent 28 of the local housing distribution plus 5 percent of program income is insufficient to adequately 29 pay the necessary costs of administering the local housing assistance plan. The cost of administering the program may not exceed 10 percent of the local housing distribution plus 5% 30 31 of program income deposited into the trust fund, except that eligible municipalities receiving a

1	local housing distribution of up to \$350,000 may use up to 10 percent of program income for
2	administrative costs; and
3	WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Improvement Department has prepared a three-year
4	Local Housing Assistance Plan for submission to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation; and
5	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the public for the
6	City of Gainesville to submit the Local Housing Assistance Plan for review and approval so as to
7	qualify for said documentary stamp tax funds.
8	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
9	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA that:
10	Section 1. The City Commission of the City of Gainesville hereby approves the Local
11	Housing Assistance Plan attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated hereto, for submission to the
12	Florida Housing Finance Corporation as required by Sections 420.907-420-9079, Florida
13	Statutes, for fiscal years 2014-2015, 2015-2016, and 2016-2017.
14	Section 2. The Mayor is hereby designated and authorized to execute any documents and
15	certifications required by the Florida Housing Finance Corporation as related to the Local
16	Housing Assistance Plan, including the Certification attached as Exhibit "B" and incorporated
17	hereto, and to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the terms and conditions of said
18	program.
19	Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
