





- Dec. 2013 Voluntary Annexation
- Oct. 2012 Wild Spaces Public Places
 City land acquisition
- Acquired for conservation & passive recreation – will expand Cone Park
- Increases green space & passive recreation in East Gainesville



- Pine-dominated uplands on S side, hardwood wetlands on N side w/in headwater floodplain of Lake Forest Creek watershed
- Good quality pine flatwoods & forested wetland communities, but soil subsidence in forested wetland from past channelization of Lake Forest Creek



- Adjacent parcels to N & NE in East Side Greenway (Morningside Greenway)
 Strategic Ecosystem, which connects East Gainesville natural areas & parks w/Gum Root Swamp, Newnan's Lake, Paynes Prairie
- CON zoning optimal for surface water quality, flood storage capacity, protection of natural resources & public parkland in East Gainesville



- No transportation issues. TMPA Zone A. RTS Route 7 nearby service @ 60 minutes weekdays Downtown and Eastwood Meadows (SE 43rd ST, north of Eastside High School)
- FEMA Flood Zone X (minimal flood hazard)



Highlights

- City zoning required for annexed properties
- Proposed CON zoning compatible w/adjacent properties & surrounding area, consistent w/Comp. Plan
- Located in Plan East Gainesville area
- This Wild Spaces Public Places land acquisition will expand conservation & passive recreation area of City's Cone Park
