#### Abstract

A Resolution of the City of Gainesville, Florida authorizing special magistrate(s) to conduct code enforcement proceedings related to violations of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances; terminating the authority of the code enforcement board; terminating the current terms of the code enforcement board members; providing a repealing clause, and providing effective dates.


WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 2-376 of the City Code, the code enforcement board and special magistrate(s) are alternative authorities for code enforcement hearings and fines, but shall not exercise such powers concurrently.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 2-376 of the City Code, the City Commission must, by resolution, specify whether the board or magistrate is authorized to act.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY

## OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Effective at 12:00 a.m. on October 1, 2014, any special magistrate(s) under contract with the City for code enforcement proceedings are authorized to exercise all authority granted under Chapter 2, Article V, Division 8 of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances and Chapter 162, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Effective at 11:59 p.m. on September 30, 2014 the authority of the code enforcement board and the current terms of all members of the code enforcement board are terminated and no further members shall be appointed until such time as the City Commission reauthorizes the code enforcement board to exercise powers.

Section 3. All resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed. This resolution shall remain
in effect until amended or repealed.
