WHEREAS, notice was given as required by law that the Zoning Map Atlas of the City of Gainesville, Florida, be amended by rezoning the property that is the subject of this ordinance from Alachua County Single Family, Low Density (RE-1) district to City of Gainesville Conservation (CON) district; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2014, a public hearing was held by the City Plan Board, which acts as the local planning agency pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, and makes recommendations to the City Commission of the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by ten (10) inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation and provided the public with at least seven (7) days' advance notice of this ordinance's first public hearing to be held by the City Commission in the City Hall Auditorium, located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by ten (10) inches long was placed in the aforesaid newspaper and provided the public with at least five (5) days' advance notice of this ordinance's second public hearing to be held by the City Commission; and

1	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notices described above at which
2	hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard;

4	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the rezoning of the property described
5	herein will be consistent with the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan when City of
6	Gainesville Ordinance No. 130793 becomes effective as provided therein.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
8	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
9	Section 1. The Zoning Map Atlas of the City of Gainesville is amended by rezoning the
10	following property from Alachua County Single Family, Low Density (RE-1) district to City of
11	Gainesville Conservation (CON) district:
12 13 14 15	See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on Exhibit "B" for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, Exhibit "A" shall prevail over Exhibit "B".
16	Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized and directed to make the
17	necessary changes to the Zoning Map Atlas to comply with this ordinance.
18	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
19	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
20	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given
21	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the
22	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
23	Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption; however,

such conflict hereby repealed.
