- WHEREAS, on January 6, 2009, and on December 2, 2014, the Historic Preservation Board
- 3 recommended that two structures generally located at 207 NE 7<sup>th</sup> Street, as more specifically
- 4 described in this ordinance, be designated contributing structures in the Northeast Residential
- 5 Historic District; and
- WHEREAS, the City Plan Board, which acts as the local planning agency pursuant to
- 7 Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, held a public hearing on January 22, 2015, and voted to
- 8 recommend that the City Commission adopt this ordinance to deem the subject structures as
- 9 contributing structures to the Northeast Residential Historic District; and
- 10 WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days' notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper
- of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City
- Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and
- WHEREAS, at least thirty (30) days' notice has been given by mail to the real property
- owner(s) affected by enactment of this ordinance and whose address is known by reference to the
- 15 latest ad valorem tax records, notifying such property owner(s) of this proposed ordinance and of a
- public hearing in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of
- 17 Gainesville; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the public hearing was held pursuant to the notice described above at which
- 19 hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
- 21 CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
- 22 Section 1. The structures located at 207 NE 7<sup>th</sup> Street and identified in Exhibit "A",
- 23 which is attached and made a part hereof as if set forth in full, are determined to meet the criteria for

1	significance and integrity as set forth in Section 30-112 of the Land Development Code and, as a
2	result, are deemed to be contributing structures to the Northeast Residential Historic District and
3	shall be subject to the provisions of Section 30-112 of the Land Development Code.
4	Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized and directed to make the necessary
5	changes to the Northeast Residential Historic District map to comply with this ordinance.
6	Section 3. The Clerk of the Commission or designee is authorized and directed to record a
7	copy of this ordinance in the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida.
8	Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or
9	the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding
10	shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without
11	the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12	ordinance are declared severable.
13	Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of
14	such conflict hereby repealed.
15	Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
