- April 2, 2015 Seeking approval from City Commission to negotiate and execute a contract w/ vendor
- January 2016 Construction of dewatering facilities complete
- February 2016 Regulatory deadline for discontinuing current program



RFP Evaluation Factors

- 45% Annualized Operating Cost
- 20% Risk
- 20% Flexibility
- 5% Enhanced Environmental Benefits
- 5% Enhanced Economic Benefits
- 5% Local Preference

Fiscal Impact

- 5-year contract
- Annual cost ~ \$1M per year
- Partially offset by the discontinuation of the existing biosolids program
- Net increase in annual operating and maintenance cost ~\$300,000 per year



Recommendation

The City Commission authorize the Interim General Manager, or her designee, to:

- 1. Negotiate and execute a five-year contract with GreenTechnologies, LLC for transportation and beneficial reuse or disposal of dewatered biosolids and;
- 2. Approve the issuance of purchase orders in amounts not to exceed budgeted amount for each year of the contract, subject to the final appropriation of funds for each year.
