# Painted Intersections and Crosswalks

### City of Madison

- Decorative Pavement Painting Ordinance
  - Local Streets speed limit </= 25 mph</li>
  - Application for painting
  - Application for Street Closure
  - Requires Indemnification of City and proof of insurance
  - Requires Traffic Engineers approval for location
  - Requires letter of support from applicable Alder
  - Requires non-slippery paint




### City of Boulder

- Paint the Pavement Program
  - Local streets </= 1,250 vehicles per day for mid-block; 2,500 for intersections
  - Application for mural
  - Permit for street closure
  - Requires Traffic Engineer's approval for location
  - Requires Boulder Arts Commission approval for art
  - Paint must not be retroreflective; traffic paint

#### City of Ft. Lauderdale

- Connecting the Blocks Painted Intersection Project
  - City led project of 3 intersections as part of complete streets initiative
  - Brought in an artist
  - Painting performed by volunteers
  - Used non-slip paint
  - Brought intersection up to ADA standards as well
