 - f. loss of wages and or loss of earning capacity in the future.

All losses are continuing and or permanent.

- 9. Plaintiff will suffer or incur the injuries, expenses and impairment in the future.
- 10. Plaintiff has submitted a Notice of Claim, by certified mail, to the appropriate agencies and included the information required by Florida Statute §768.28. Attached as Exhibit "A" is the Notice of Claim which was submitted on May 8, 2013.
