A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO ITS GENERAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2014 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2015; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 140302 AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 140698 AND RESOLUTION NO. 150054, BY MAKING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE GENERAL OPERATING AND FINANCIAL PLAN BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2014, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, adopted Resolution No. 140302 for the purpose of approving and adopting a final budget for Fiscal Year 2014-2015;

WHEREAS, the City Commission has adopted Resolution No. 140698 and Resolution No. 150054 which amended Resolution No. 140302 by amending the General Financial and Operating Plan Budget as set forth therein;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make certain amendments to the General Financial and Operating Plan Budget.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires now to amend the General Financial and Operating Plan Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The General Financial and Operating Plan Budget for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 is hereby amended as set forth in Attachment "A" which is attached hereto and made part hereof as if set forth in full.

1           **Section 2.** Except as herein above modified and amended, the General Financial and  
2 Operating Plan Budget for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 as adopted by Resolution No. 140302 and  
3 amended by Resolution No. 140698 and Resolution No. 150054 shall continue and remain in full

5           **Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
