



#### Petition / Background

- Request to vacate ROW to remove platted streets w/in a 5.5-ac, City-owned property used as passive park (SW 5<sup>th</sup> AVE Stormwater Park). Undeveloped except for master stormwater basin surrounded by paved pedestrian path.
- 1.27 ac of platted street segments that are "paper streets" that were never built, have no prospect of becoming local streets, and do not serve a public purpose as a ROW.



## **Basis for Recommendation**

- 1. Whether the public benefits from use of the subject right-of-way as part of city street system.
- 2. Whether the proposed action is consistent with Comprehensive Plan.
- 3. Whether the proposed action would deny access to private property.
- 4. The effect of proposed action upon public safety.
- 5. The effect of proposed action upon safety of pedestrians and vehicular traffic.



## **Basis for Recommendation**

- 6. The effect of proposed action upon provision of municipal services including, but not limited to, emergency service and waste removal.
- 7. The necessity to relocate utilities, both public and private.
- 8. The effect of proposed action on design and character of the area.
