WHEREAS, abused or neglected children are at much greater risk of becoming abusive and neglectful parents; and

WHEREAS, prevention services can reduce the cost society must bear in dealing with the results of child abuse and neglect and can help children and families avoid the overburdened and expensive social welfare and criminal justice systems; and

WHEREAS, children deserve the opportunity to grow and thrive in healthful environments free from threats of violence and harm. During the month of April, public and private-sector agencies, child care professionals, child advocates and residents will be increasing the public's awareness of child abuse and neglect prevention.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edward B. Braddy, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim April, 2016 as

Child Abuse Prevention Month

in the City of Gainesville and invite all our citizens to join me and increase participation in our efforts to prevent child abuse, thereby strengthening the community in which we live.
