In a prepared statement ionday, Corizon Chief Execuve Officer Karey Witty alluded those issues.

"We appreciate the contracts or inmate health services ermit very little of the flexibily that Secretary Jones would ke in order to address issues ich as staffing, mental health are, and electronic health cords," Witty said. "We have ied to address the departent's concerns but have found e terms of the current contract o constraining. At this point, e believe the best way to move forward is to focus our efforts on a successful transition to a new provider."

McKinley Lewis, a department spokesman, said in an email that Jones met Monday with Corizon and received notice of the cancellation. The email said a contract with another healthcare provider, Wexford Health Sources, will continue.

"In the coming months, Secretary Jones will work closely with the Department's Office of Health Services to ensure that the appropriate staff and resources are available at our facilities to continue seamless delivery of appropriate medical care to our inmate population," Lewis said in the email. "While Corizon has terminated its contract with the Department of Corrections, we will continue

our partnership with Wexford Health Sources and will work closely with their leadership throughout this process."

A legislative decision in 2011 to privatize prison healthcare services was highly controversial and drew legal challenges. But ultimately, Tennessee-based Corizon and Pennsylvania-based Wexford received contracts to move

Corizon provides health services at prisons across North Florida and Central Florida, such as at Florida State Prison in Bradford County and other institutions that are critical employers in rural areas.

In a news release Monday, Corizon said it would work with the Department of Corrections "to plan a transition schedule and to mitigate employee concerns regarding their future employment. This is will help ensure a stable environment for safe and effective clinical care for the patients during this changeover."

Jones' announcement in February that she wanted to re-bid the health contracts came amid intense scrutiny of the prison system. While that scrutiny included prison health care, it focused heavily on issues such as reports about guards abusing inmates and allegations of cover-ups.

Under the current agreements, Corizon receives \$229 million per year. Wexford, which provides services in a smaller number of prisons in South Florida, is being paid \$48 million a year.

Pursuant to Section 30-345 of the City's LDC we are providing this letter as satisfaction of the General Performance Standards as set forth in the section. The Palm Garden of Gainesville project meets the standards as follows:

- 1. Fire and explosion hazards: Limited storage of flammable or explosive materials are proposed at the site, and will have adequate safety devices against such hazards.
- 2. Radiation: No radiation operations are proposed for this development.
- 3. Electromagnetic radiation: No electromagnetic radiation is proposed for this development.
- 4. Air pollution emissions: No smoke or particulate matter will be discharged from this development without proper treatment and permitting with ACEPD.
- 5. Toxics: No toxic or noxious matter exceeding ambient air quality standards will be discharged from this development.
- 6. Toxic or noxious matter: No activity involving toxic or noxious matter is proposed for this development.
- 7. Waste disposal: This site will not discharge waste (liquid or solid) that will result in a violation of local, state or federal regulations.
- 8. Vibration: This use will not create any vibrations as defined in this section.
- 9. Heat, cold, dampness, or movement of air: The proposed use of the site will not affect temperature, motion or humidity of the atmosphere.
- 10. Glare: The site plan meets the City's lighting ordinance and therefore meets the performance standard for glare.
- 11. Noise. Odor, etc.: Use of the site will not create noise, odor or any other irritant that will unreasonably disturb the adjoining lands.

In addition, all proposed utilities are to be underground except for those apertures (i.e.: transformers, fire hydrants, etc.) that are defined by code to be allowed to be above grade.
