Background

Similarly named use (*Hard armor systems manufacturing and assembly*) added in 2012 to AF zoning district enabled local high-tech start-up company to operate at Gainesville Regional Airport (GNV)

Phalanx Defense Systems has become very successful, outgrowing its space in former FAA building at GNV

Phalanx designs & manufactures body armor & related safety equipment for public safety workers and US military using previously processed recycled materials



Petition

Addition of high-tech, low-impact, niche use of *Armor* systems manufacturing and assembly as permitted use, w/conditions, to MU-1 zoning district


Armor systems include armor safety products & personal protective equipment (such as body armor, bullet proof vests, similar products)



Petition

Among proposed Conditions:

- ✓ Manufacturing & assembly in completely enclosed structures >= 100 ft. from properties w/residential land use
- ✓ No outdoor storage
- ✓ Loading docks & mechanical equipment must be screened
- √ Sound attenuation
- ✓Indoor gun range as accessory use, strictly limited to product testing & demonstration, sound attenuation required
