2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the Code of Ordinances relating to the Utility Advisory Board by amending Section 2-359 to revise the attendance requirements for the Utility Advisory Board, providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
10 11	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days' notice has been given once by publication in a
12	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of the
13	public hearings in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of
14	Gainesville; and
15	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described
16	above, at which all interested parties had an opportunity to be, and were, in fact, heard.
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
18	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
19	Section 1. Section 2-359 (e) of the Code of Ordinances is amended as follows. Except
20	as amended herein, the remainder of Section 2-359 remains in full force and effect.
21	Division 7. Utility Advisory Board
22	Sec. 2-359. Utility Board; membership; terms; officers; procedural rules.
23	(e) Attendance. Utility board members are required to attend all regular and special meetings
24	of the utility board. Each utility board member may be granted two four excused absences
25	per calendar year. A utility board member shall notify the board secretary of an absence
26	prior to the meeting, if practicable.

1	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1
2	shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida,
3	and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in orde
4	to accomplish such intentions.
5	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
6	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
7	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
8	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
9	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
10	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
11	such conflict hereby repealed.
12	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
