| 18 | amended herein, the remainder of Section 28-8 remains in full force and effect. |
| 19 | CHAPTER 28 - VEHICLES FOR HIRE |
| 20 | Sec. 28-8. Operating regulations. |
| 21 | (a) In addition to all other applicable legal requirements, it shall be unlawful for any person: |
| 22 | (1) To operate a VFH without a company issued driver authorization; |
| 23 | (2) To operate a VFH while under the influence of alcoholic beverages or controlled |
| 24 | substances, other than medication prescribed by a physician, provided that such |
| 25 | prescribed medication does not warn that the user not operate machinery while |

| 13 | | regarding non-discrimination against passengers or potential passengers on the basis of |
| 14 | | destination, race, color, national origin, religion, disability, gender, gender identity, or |

| 16 | (d) | Each company and driver shall comply with all applicable laws relating to the Americans |
| 17 | | with Disabilities Act, including the accommodation of service animals. |
| 18 | (e) | A driver shall at all times carry in the VFH proof of the insurance policies required by this |

| 20 | (f) | Drivers shall not: |
