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16	WHEREAS, on July 28, 2016, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida
17	adopted Resolution No. 160160 which approved a Proposed Tentative General Government
18	Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and
19	WHEREAS, on July 28, 2016, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 160159
20	approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Proposed Tentative General
21	Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget; and
22	WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rate established in Resolution No. 160159,
23	on or about August 15, 2016, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of
24	Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and
25	WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a
26	public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Tentative
27	General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the proposed millage necessary to
28	fund the said budget; and
29	WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed
30	Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;
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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

3	Section 1. The tentative operating millage rate of 4.5079 mills to fund the Tentative
4	General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville's 2016-
5	2017 fiscal year is hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable law.
6	Section 2. The tentative operating millage rate approved herein is more than the rolled-
7	back rate of 4.4057 mills, which results in a 2.32% increase in property taxes.
8	Section 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the final millage rate and final
9	budget for general municipal purpose on Thursday, the 15 th day of September, 2016, at 6:00 p.m.
10	or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of
11	City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida.
12	Section 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all
13	necessary and required notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide a copy of
14	this resolution to all parties as may be required by law.
15	Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
