


Project Scope

Project #1 : Innovation Square Stormwater *Upgrades*


- Re-route 72" Storm Sewer Pipe = 350 LF
- SW 5th Avenue Headwall Improvements / Overlook
- Onsite Stormwater Treatment Facility

Project #2 : Southpark Apartments

- Southeast Corner of SW 4th Ave. & SW 9th Dr.
- 4/5 Story 65-unit Apartment Building
- Koi Pond / Stormwater Overlook

Project #3 : SW 9th Street Extension South Urban Walkway

 Extend SW 9th Street Pedestrian Path / Linear Park (Includes lighting, hardscape, landscaping, site furnishings, and finishes)






SW 9th Street Extension **Stormwater Improvements Approved By City Commission On** July 21, 2016 In The Amount Of \$784,057

Project #3 : SW 9th Street Extension South Urban Walkway


- Construction Starts Spring 2018

SW 9th Street Extension South – Proposed Funding



46% Trimark = \$890,000 (Land Costs Not Included)

Design, Engineering, Testing, Survey, Materials, Site Work, Stormwater, Hardscape, Landscape, Utilities

40% Public Works = \$784,057

Survey, Earthwork, Demolition, Materials, Hardscape, Stormwater

14% CRA = \$277,619

Hardscape, Landscape, Lighting, Utilities, Site Furnishings
