22	result of Humeane Hemme, and		
23	WHEREAS, upon approval of the grant application, the Federal Emergency		
24	Management Agency will reimburse the City 75% of eligible expenses and the State of		
25	Florida will reimburse the City 10% of eligible expenses. The City is responsible for		
26	15% of the eligible expenses; and

28	WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency requires the City to		
29	adopt a resolution authorizing designated signatories.

31	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION

33	Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute and submit Federal Emergency
