

History



Strike Out Hunger Week: History

- September 16, 2008, Alachua County Initiated the first Strike Out Hunger Food Drive held at Citizens Field in recognition of National Hunger Month and to promote the first Hunger Summit.
- In 2008 26, 000 pounds of food was collected.
- September 18, 2008, the first Hunger Summit sponsored by Alachua County, City of Gainesville, Alachua County Medical Society, Alachua County School Board and United Way to begin the process of developing a Hunger Abatement Plan.

Strike Out Hunger Week: History

- July 2009, Alachua County approved the Hunger Abatement Plan.
- 2009, City of Gainesville adopts the Hunger Abatement Plan.
- Alachua County Nutrition Alliance (ACNA) organized to implement the HAP Plan.
- 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015 Community Wide Strike Out Hunger Food Drives were held at The Fairgrounds as a public/private partnership.

Outcomes Report

- Over 100 organizations participated in the Strike out Hunger Week: Food Drive, Farmshare Food Giveaway, Food Banks and Pantries Food Giveaway & Thanksgiving Basket Giveaway Program.
- Nearly 100 volunteers donated an average of 4 hours towards Strike Out Hunger Week.
- Nearly 2000 Thanksgiving Baskets with turkeys were distributed to families in Alachua County.
- 900 Families were served through the Alachua County School District Partnership.

2016 Strike Out Hunger:

Outcomes Report

- Over 14,000 pounds of turkeys were distributed to needy families.
- Nearly 120,000 pounds of non-perishable food items were collected and distributed.
- Over 20, 000 pounds of perishable food items impacting 440 families were donated by FarmShare and distributed to needy families.

2016 Strike Out Hunger:

Outcomes Report

Nearly 140,000 pounds of non-perishable and perishable food items were collected and distributed through the Strike out Hunger Food Drive, FarmShare Food Giveaway, Alachua County School District, collection of nonperishable food items sponsored by other organizations and delivered directly to food banks, pantries or back pack programs.

- City of Gainesville donates the use of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Multi-Purpose Center and the Thomas Center for planning meetings. We have confirmed the above facilities on the dates and times listed in the below Strike Out Hunger Week Timelines and Critical Dates.
- Issue a proclamation at the October 19, 2017 City Commission Meeting in recognition of November, 2017 as National Hunger Month.
- Appoint a designee from the City of Gainesville to attend the planning meetings and to keep the City Commission informed of the progress of the Strike Out Hunger Week.

- The Mayor, Manager or his designee attend if possible and participate in the Strike Out Hunger Week Food Drive Drop off on Monday, November 13, 2017 from 8:00 am -5:00pm at the Fairgrounds.
- The Mayor, Manager or his designee participate if possible at the fairgrounds in the pick-up of donated food items by the food banks and pantries on Wednesday, November 15, 2017 from 10:00 am 2:00 pm.

- The Mayor, Manager or his designee participate if possible at the fairgrounds in the FarmShare Food Giveaway Program cosponsored by Representative Clovis Watson, Jr. on Wednesday, November 15th 12:00 – 3:00 p.m. at the fairgrounds.
- Participate if possible in the pick-up of Thanksgiving Baskets by needy families on Thursday, November 16, 2017 from 2:00 pm – 6:00 pm at the Fairgrounds.
- City of Gainesville and Gainesville Regional Utilities
 Departments and staff to coordinate and participate as one of our government organizations in the collection of non
- perishable food items for the food drive.

- <u>Public Works Department</u>: Provide the use of orange parking cones. Delivery date is November 10, 2017 at the Fairgrounds.
- Communications Department: Provide air time for pre produced public service announcements to be aired on Cox Cable Channel 12.
- The City Commission to receive a final presentation at the Monday, March 1, 2018 City Commission meeting regarding the outcomes report for 2017 Strike Out Hunger Week.
