3	WHEREAS, the City Commission at its meeting of February 16, 2017 approved the	
4	Interlocal Agreement for Election Services requiring the City Attorney to draft an ordinance	
5	to make an amendment to a section of the City's Election Code; and	
6	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a	
7	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a	
8	Public Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and	
9	WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice describe

22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF	
23	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:	
24	Section 1. Section 9-6 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is	
5	amended to read as follows:	
6	Sec. 9-6. Registration and qualifying officer designated; registration books t	
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1	The supervisor of elections of Alachua County, Florida, hereinafter referred to as
2	"supervisor" clerk of the commission is hereby designated as the registration and qualifying
3	officer for the city. Alternatively, the city may contract with the Supervisor of Elections of
4	Alachua County to serve as the registration and qualifying officer for the City. The
5	supervisor shall maintain the registration records of city electors as provided in the general
6	law of the state. The supervisor is also designated as the official in charge of all
7	administrative duties pertaining to city elections. The city shall reimburse the supervisor,
8	for the cost of conducting the elections.
9	Section 2. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this
10	ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or
11	unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the
12	ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or
13	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
14	Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the
15	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
16	Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
