14 15 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, SETTING MARCH 20, 2018 AS THE DATE FOR THE 2018 REGULAR CITY ELECTION AND MAY 1, 2018 AS THE DATE FOR THE 2018 RUN-OFF ELECTION, IF NECESSARY; SETTING THE EARLY VOTING DATES FOR THE 2018 REGULAR CITY ELECTION AND 2018 RUN-OFF ELECTION, IF NECESSARY; SETTING THE DATES FOR QUALIFYING FOR THE 2018 REGULAR ELECTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2(b) of the Code of Ordinances the City
 Commission is to adopt an ordinance setting the date of the next regular election by July 1st
 of each year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances the dates for any person who meets the eligibility requirements described in Article II of the City Charter and Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances to become a candidate for a seat on the City Commission by filing the necessary qualifying papers with the supervisor of elections shall run from noon of the 50th day prior to the day of the election to noon of the 46th day prior to the day of the election; and

WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The 2018 regular election for the City of Gainesville shall be held on
Tuesday, March 20, 2018; and, pursuant to Section 9-2(a) of the Code of Ordinances, the
date of the run-off election, if necessary, shall be Tuesday, May 1, 2018. The dates for early
voting for the 2018 regular election shall be from Saturday, March 10, 2018 to and including
Saturday, March 17, 2018. The dates for early voting for the 2018 run-off election, if
necessary, shall be from Saturday, April 21, 2018 to and including Saturday, April 28, 2018.

Section 2. The dates for any person who meets the eligibility requirements described 10 in Article II of the City Charter and Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances to become a 11 candidate in 2018 for a seat on the City Commission by filing the necessary qualifying 12 13 papers with the registration and qualifying officer for the City shall run from noon of the 50th day prior to the day of the election to noon of the 46th day prior to the day of the 14 election. Specifically, the qualifying dates shall be from noon on Monday, January 29, 2018 15 to noon on Friday, February 2, 2018. To the extent that the qualifying dates for the 2018 16 general election set forth herein conflict with the requirements of Section 9-10 of the Code 17 of Ordinances, the qualifying dates set forth herein shall govern and control for the 2018 18 general election. 19

20 Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this 21 ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or

1	unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the	
2	ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or	
3	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

5	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.	
6	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
