SUBJECT:	Recommended CDBG & HOME Allocations for FY 2017-2018

On behalf of the Citizens Advisory Committee for Community Development (CACCD), I am pleased to present our FY 2017-2018 CDBG & HOME funding recommendations. The Committee has based its recommendations on a thorough review of applications, site visits made by its members, applicant's presentations and comments from the public. Each project was considered on its own merits, and the Committee did is utmost to maintain the integrity of its process.

As a reminder, HUD has recommended for local governments to implement a minimum \$10,000 threshold for grant awards in order to maximize efficiency of limited resources and grant effectiveness. For the past two fiscal years (FY 2015-2016 and FY 2016-2017) the \$10,000 minimum has been in effect for the public services programs.

Our recommendations reflect the Committee's concern with making the best use of limited funds. As in previous years, the demands for CDBG and HOME funding far exceeded our ability to recommend funding for many worthy projects that are seeking financial assistance.

In addition to considering the impact of each project proposal, the Committee ensured that all recommended projects supported one or more of the following funding priorities established by the City Commission:

-Housing	-Homeless assistance
-Nutritional Support	-Job training/employment opportunities
-Senior Programs	-Youth Programs (at-risk)

Please note that the CACCD's recommendations are limited to the "competitive" funding under CDBG and HOME, which has allowed the CACCD and applicants to focus on amounts that were realistically available for allocation to community nonprofit organizations.

You should have a report that shows all requests for CDBG and/or HOME funds, along with our recommendations under each activity category by agency. Please note that the CACCD's recommendations are based on the following funding levels for FY 2017-2018

CDBG Competitive Amount Available = \$184,635

HOME Competitive Amount Available=\$100,966
