9 10	WHEREAS, notice was given as required by law that the text of the City of Gainesville
11	Code of Ordinances be amended; and
12	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days' notice has been given once by publication in a
13	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public
14	hearings in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of
15	Gainesville; and
16	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notice described above at which
17	hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
19	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
20	Section 1. Section 2-641 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is
21	amended to read as follows.
22	Sec. 2-641 Definitions.
23	City shall mean the City of Gainesville, Florida.
24	City group health plan shall mean the group insurance or self insurance plan(s)

maintained by the city to provide health coverage for eligible employees, retirees and

dependents.

1	Credited service shall mean service with the city upon which the retirement benefit the
2	retiree is receiving (or will be receiving in the case of delayed retirement) is based, or would be
3	based in the case of an "ICMA" retiree.
4	Current premium costs shall mean the payment of the current months premium owed or
5	owing to the city group health plan for such month's retiree health insurance coverage as of the

owing to the city group health plan for such month's retiree health insurance coverage as of the effective date of the termination of the plan pursuant to section 2-652(b).

DROP means a deferred retirement option program as set forth in the city firefighters retirement plan.

Participant means a retiree or dependent as defined in the city group health plan.

Premium shall mean the monthly amount(s) the city charges for retiree health insurance coverage, including, if applicable, under a Medicare supplement plan, as established by the city manager.

Retiree shall mean:

- A former employee, who is a member of the city employees pension plan or a (1) member of the consolidated police officers and firefighters retirement plan and received, immediately after separation from employment, a monthly annuity pursuant to an application for normal or early retirement, in accordance with the provisions of these pension plans; or
- A former employee upon whose behalf employer contributions were made to the (2) ICMA deferred compensation program and/or 401(a) plan and who, at the time of their separation from the city, would have met the age and/or service requirements for normal or early retirement under the city employee pension plan or the consolidated police officers and firefighters retirement plan as applicable to the

1		classification they held at the time of their separation, and would have been		
2		entitled to the immediate receipt of a monthly annuity; or		
3	(3)	A former employee, who is a member of the consolidated police officers and		
4		firefighters retirement plan and is receiving a monthly annuity pursuant to an		
5		approved application for disability retirement in accordance with the provisions of		
6		that pension plan; or		
7	(4)	A former employee of the city receiving a monthly benefit pursuant to an		
8		approved application for disability retirement under the city employee's disability		
9		plan or disability benefit under the city employees pension plan.		
10	Retire	e health insurance program shall mean the retiree health insurance program		
11	established pursuant to this article as further described herein to pay a portion of the premium			
12	costs of the ci	ty group health plan for eligible retirees of the city and then eligible dependents,		
13	and as may be amended.			
14	Section	on 2. Section 2-643(3) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is		
15	amended to re	ead as follows.		
16	Sec. 2-643	City contributions for future retirees.		
17	(3)	Disability retirees. The amount that the city will contribute towards the required		
18		premium, for persons who became retirees based upon an application for		
19		disability retirement submitted after August 31, 2008, will be:		
20		a. For approved "in-line-of-duty" disabilities under the consolidated police		
21		officers and firefighters retirement plan, or the city employees disability		
22		plan, or the city employees pension plan, the city will contribute towards		
23		an individual premium an amount equal to 80 percent of the individual		

1		premium of the least costly (lowest premium) city group health insurance
2		plan option being offered at the time the disability retirement is approved.
3	b.	For approved "in-line-of-duty" disabilities under the consolidated police
4		officers and firefighters retirement plan, or the city employees disability
5		plan, or the city employees pension plan, the city will contribute towards
6		any other (than described in subsection a. above) tier of coverage an
7		amount equal to 150 percent of the individual premium of the least costly
8		(lowest premium) city group health insurance plan option being offered at
9		the time the disability retirement is approved.
LO	C.	For approved disabilities other than "in-line-of-duty", the city will
1.1		contribute 50 percent of the amount described in subsections a. and b.
12		above.
13	Section 3. It	is the intent of the City Commission that the provisions of Sections 1 and 2
L 4	of this ordinance sh	all become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
15	Gainesville, Florida,	and that the sections and paragraphs of the Code of Ordinances may be
16	renumbered or relette	ered in order to accomplish such intent.
17	Section 4. If	any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
18	or the application he	reof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
19	finding shall not aff	ect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given
20	effect without the i	invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
