REPRESENTATIVE APPELLATE MATTERS

- 1. <u>Behnam v. Zadeh</u>, 132 So. 3d 951 (Fla. Dist. Ct. App. 1st Dist. 2014). Reversal of trial court's entry of a summary judgment, where party sought dismissal and no summary judgment motion filed.
- 2. <u>Jones v. Jones</u>, 51 So. 3d 547 Fla. 1st DCA 2011). Finding that promissory note was a marital debt pursuant to § 61.075(5)(a)(1), Fla. Stat. was proper because the husband signed the note during the parties' marriage. Further, where the note's true value was somewhere between the face value and zero, the trial court did not err by discounting the face amount to achieve an equitable distribution.
- 3. <u>Wagner v. Wagner</u>, 61 So. 3d 1141 (Fla 1st DCA 2011; and A difference of 5% in the assets distributed to the parties via equitable distribution was reversed. "Close enough" is not the applicable standard for justifying an unequal distribution of marital and non-marital assets. The matter was remanded to the trial court for findings of fact to justify an unequal distribution.

In a child visitation case, trial court's order went too far by purporting to fashion remedies that were hypothetical. The appellate court granted mother's petition for writ of certiorari and guashed portions of order.
- 7. <u>Williams v. Spears</u>, Case No. 98-926, 719 So. 2d 1236; 1998 Fla. App. LEXIS 12461; 23 Fla. L. Weekly D 2276, October 7, 1998, First District Court of Appeal of Florida. Florida statute regarding grandparent visitation was unconstitutional where divorced parents were in agreement that a court should not order the grandparent visitation.
- 8. Neely v. Neely, Case No. 96-2861, 691 So. 2d 39; 1997 Fla. App. LEXIS 3156; 22 Fla. L. Weekly D 883, April 4, 1997, First District Court of Appeal of Florida. Ex-husband was not entitled to modification of the child custody arrangement with his ex-wife because there was no determination of a change in circumstances and of the child's best interests.
- 9. Edgar v. Edgar, Case No. 94-1300, 677 So. 2d 1359; 1996 Fla. App. LEXIS 8348; 21 Fla. L. Weekly D 1825, August 12, 1996, First District Court of Appeal of Florida. The trial court abused its discretion by finding appellant former wife rehabilitated and not awarding her sufficient rehabilitative alimony to allow her to become capable of earning some semblance of the lifestyle enjoyed during the long marriage.
